

Amateur Radio Technician License Class

Beginning September 14th

An amateur radio Technician License class begins September 14th in Mason, Michigan, at the Mason Community Services Building, 118 W. Oak St., Mason, Michigan. The class runs 10:00 a.m. – noon. There is no fixed fee for this class, although participants are urged to make a free will contribution (suggest \$10 or more) to Mason Community Services for allowing use of their facilities for this class. Pre-registration is not required.

There is no age requirement for obtaining an amateur radio license.

Parking is available in the small lot at the west side of the building, and there is additional street parking nearby.

The class will run each Saturday for six weeks, September 14, 21, 28, October 5, 12, 19. Attending every class is not a requirement – the goal is to pass the Technician License class exam which will be conducted after the last class.
