


Most people who took this survey were members.


Some notes from what would increase interest in joining:

Most people in this survey (more than 77%) were willing to pay \$30 a year for dues.




- 37 from Ingham County




# Distance Willing to Drive for Contests / Classes

79 responses






Are you interested in receiving more information about the Lansing / Ingham Amateur Radio Public Service Corps (ARPSC) and how to volunteer through RACES for public service events?


