



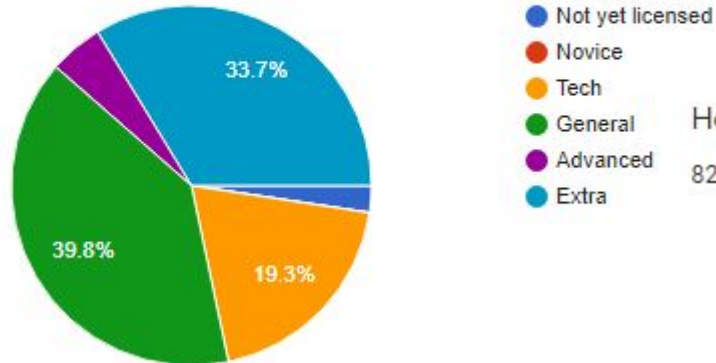

Demographics

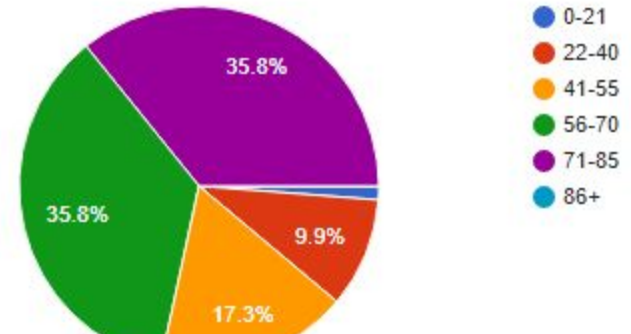
What is your license class?

83 responses



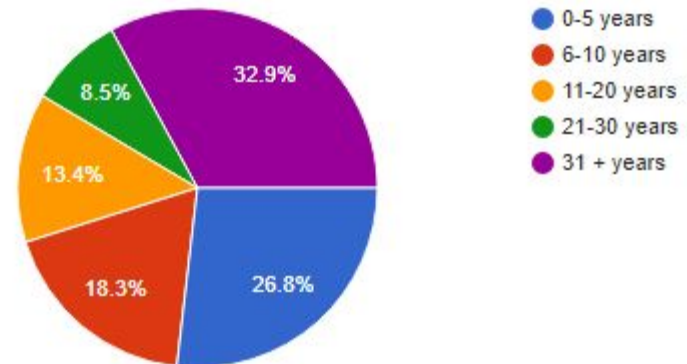
What is your age?

How long have you been a Ham?

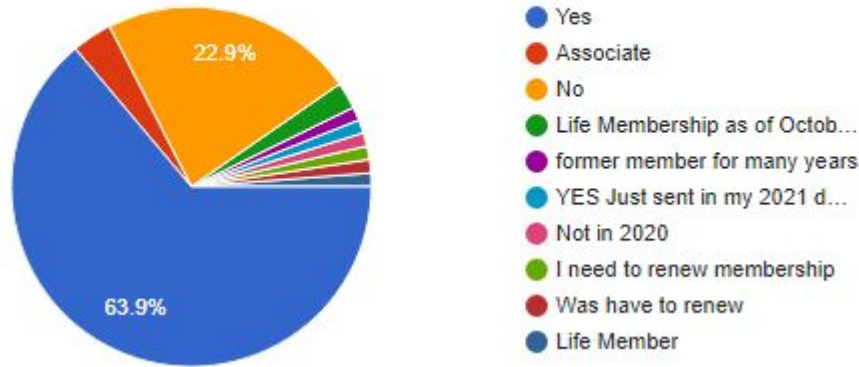

Most people who took this survey were members.

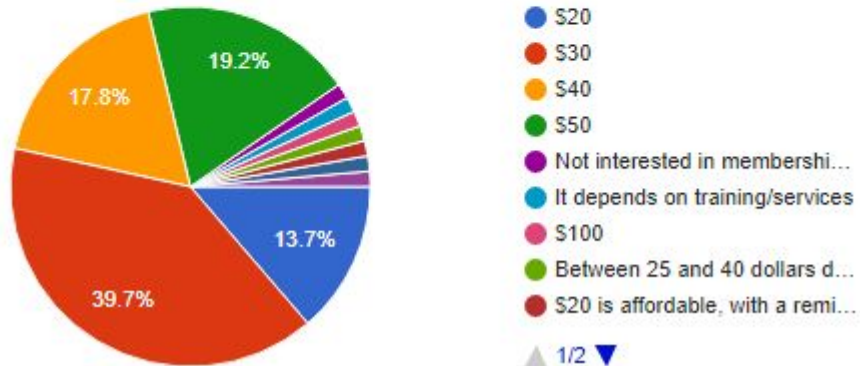
Some notes from what would increase interest in joining:

Most people in this survey (more than 77%) were willing to pay \$30 a year for dues.

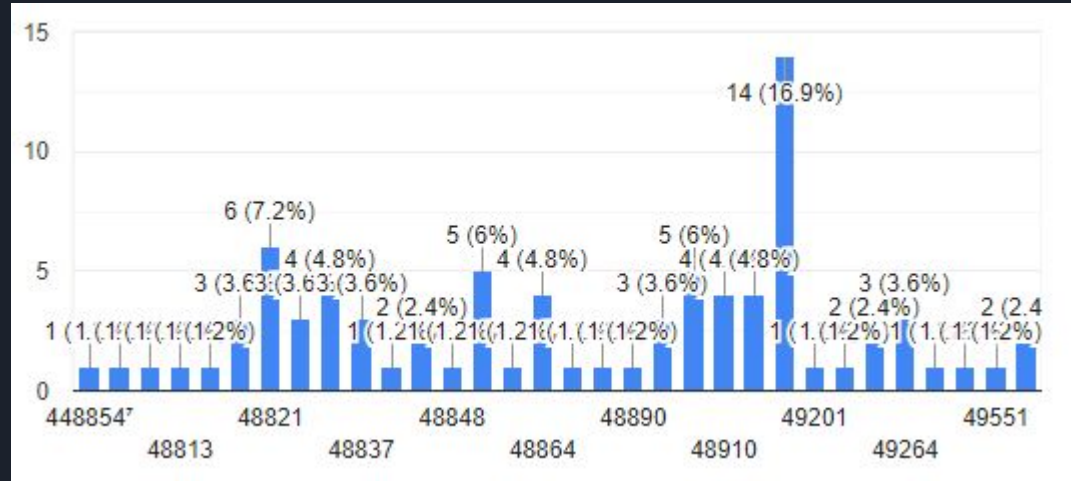

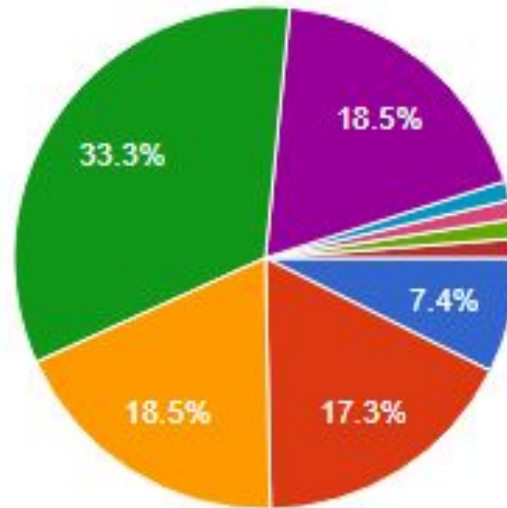
- 37 from Ingham County

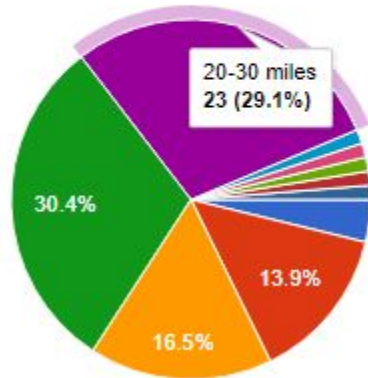

How far are you willing to drive for use of the club station (contests, special events, etc.)?

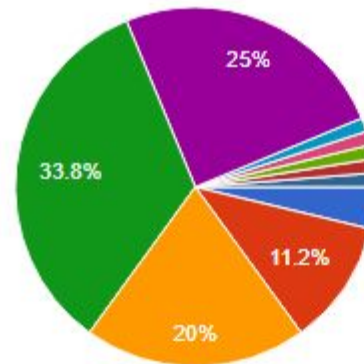

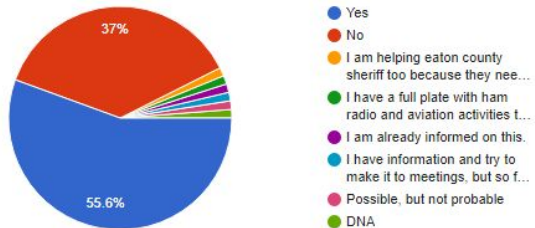

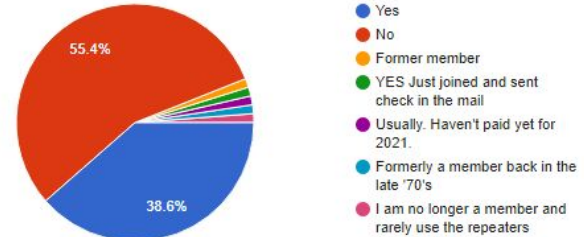

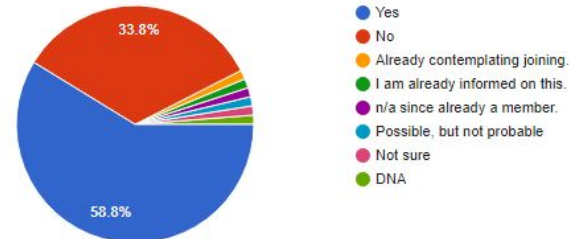
